



Position Description – Team Captain

The role of the Team Captain is to equally motivate team members to participate to their highest ability, leading by example with integrity.

Desirable Attributes:

The Team Captain should:

- be a person who can develop good relationships internally and externally.
- be forward thinking and committed to meeting the goals of the Team and the Club.
- be a good listener and attuned to the interests of players.
- be a good role model and a positive image in representing the Club.
- be able to raise concerns with the Team Coach where they arise.

Specific duties include but are not limited to:

- Ensure all welfare and safety requirements for the team are met at all times.
- Encourage participants to gain and develop skills, knowledge and techniques.
- Inspire confidence and self-belief.
- Ensure all available players remain courtside during matches.
- Ensure all players undertake sufficient hydration before, during and after participation.
- Lead warm-up at both training sessions and competition.
- Encourage team spirit and unity within the team.
- Ensure that all players attend training and matches, providing the Team Coach with advice on absences as soon as known.
- Notify all players and/or parents of any changes to training or match scheduling.
- Maintain an equitable roster for umpiring and scoring duties for all games, at least 48hrs in advance and provide notification to duty players.
- Ensure all equipment is accounted for and in good order before & after competition and training. Arrange suitable replacement in liaison Team Coach and Equipment Coordinator.
- Act as Team liaison with the Umpires when on court.
- Comply with the VWA Code of Conduct at all times.
- Abide by the Volleyball WA Competition By Laws at all times.
- Ensure that all players conform to the appropriate dress standards for competition and umpiring.

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
