2022 TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR MEMBERS OF NORTHERN STARS VOLLEYBALL CLUB INC

1. Financial Compliance

I, the athlete or parent/guardian, hereby declare that as a member of Northern Stars Volleyball Club I agree to complete and pay the athlete's Volleyball Western Australia (VWA) Membership for season 2023/24 online. I accept that the athlete is not allowed to play in any VWA-sanctioned event until this is complete, and that any fines the club receives that result from the athlete doing so are fully and exclusively payable by athlete or parent/guardian in breach of this agreement.

I, the athlete or parent/guardian, also agree to be fully financial with the club, with fees either paid in full or ongoing compliance with an agreed payment plan prior to the commencement of the Western Australian Volleyball League (WAVL) and/or Western Australian Volleyball Junior League (WAVJL) as applicable. I accept that the club reserves the right to suspend players from taking the court until financial compliance is met.

2. Membership Agreement

I, the athlete or parent/guardian, agree to Volleyball WA's 'Membership Agreement' and 'Code of Conduct' (included in my Volleyball WA Membership) and all Northern Stars Volleyball Club's 'Rules of Association' (found on the NSVC website - www.northernstarsvolleyball.com)

3. Risk of Injury Agreement

I, the athlete or parent/guardian, recognise that the athlete trains and plays at their own risk. The club cannot be held responsible for player injury provided a safe playing environment has been maintained. Personal accident insurance is available in the event of injury during VWA-sanctioned events; the Personal Accident Insurance Policy can be found on the VWA website (<https://volleyballwa.com.au/about-us/policies/>).

ADDITIONAL TERMS & CONDITIONS FOR WA VOLLEYBALL LEAGUE PARTICIPANTS

The WA Volleyball League includes State League, State League Reserves & Divisions.

4. Coaching Requirements

Once team nominations are submitted to VWA, each NSVC team will be required in 2023 to have at least one member nominate to coach for the club's next team directly below them. The player/s nominated will receive the standard coaching honorarium set out in the 2023 Coaches Guide.

Teams that do not nominate a coach for the team below them will be charged an additional \$50 per player on top of their regular season fees to cover the cost of NSVC paying for an additional coach.*

By accepting these Terms & Conditions the athlete and/or parent/guardian accepts the requirement for each team to nominate a coach for the team below and that failure to do so will incur an additional fee on top of the athletes' club fees.

**NOTE: The following only applies if the club is unable to find & assign a coach for the team directly below your nominated team. This is to ensure that we can further incentivise a coach to allow that team to participate.*

5. Referee Requirements

As part of participation in the WA Volleyball League, VWA requires each club team to perform referee duties for other games in the competition. These duties are approximately every second week and require a duty team to field, at a minimum, the following referees for a game;

- 1x First Referee with a Level 1 accreditation or greater (Level 2 accreditation required for State League & State League Reserve games)
- 1x Second Referee with a Level 1 accreditation or greater
- 1x Scorer

Failure to meet these requirements results in a \$50 fine and a championship point penalty to the team rostered for the duty.

I, the athlete, accept that these refereeing requirements are part of playing in the WA Volleyball League and that failure of a team to supply a qualified referee for the necessary position/s results in a \$50 fine per infringement and a championship point penalty. I accept that this fine is the team or athlete/s responsibility to pay in full to the club should an invoice be received.

Important Note

For season 2023, the club will fully subsidise up to three players per team to complete either a Level 1 Referee Accreditation (available to VWA members via the Fortix portal) or a Level 1 Coaching Accreditation to meet the requirements set out in Terms 4 & 5. This subsidy is available upon proof of course completion. The club also offers significant discounts to any member/s willing to upskill to a Level 2 Referee/Coach Accreditation; please contact the Club Secretary for further details if you are interested.
